- The That Man Is You! program was hosted in 784 parishes last year and is being hosted in a record high 864 parishes this fall. Thanks to the tremendous work of Deacon Carlos Ramirez, TMIY is now available in Spanish – Ese Hombre Eres Tu!
- The 4th class of Missionaries to the Family couples were commissioned and the 5th class launched at a retreat at the

 in the United States today.
- The first installment of Mark Hartfiel's video series, Mysteries
 of the Rosary, was launched last Lent. The Sorrowful Mysteries

 Mysteries have been completed and were just released this fall.

- The What Is Love? program for young adults is ready to launch. The What is Love? movie will be playing in theaters across the U.S. on October 16, 2023. 

This past fiscal year was filled with even more excitement and fruitfulness than the one before. God continues to work his miracles and outdo himself in generosity. Each year, we work hard and pray even harder to bring to life a new year of dynamic content. The fruits of this resulted in a record 93% retention rate of our TMIY groups from last year to this year! The TMIY band of brothers continues to strengthen and deepen within each local community, and we are honored to accompany them through their journey of faith.

Less than two years ago, God placed a desire and calling in

my heart to create the *Mysteries of the Rosary* video series. By the grace of God and your swift and generous support of this initiative, by October 7, 2023, The Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, we will have launched a seven-episode series for both the Sorrowful and Joyful Mysteries! The Sorrowful Mysteries' episodes are already reaching audiences everywhere from Catholic classrooms, TMIY men's groups, women's groups, naval bases, home groups, and individual viewers. It is distributed on Paradisus Dei's new video platform *programs.paradisusdei.org*, Wild Goose TV, FORMED and will soon be featured on EWTN and other distribution partnerships very soon. This new initiative is already reaching and impacting tens of thousands of souls that Paradisus Dei was not previously reaching. Thanks be to God!

Missionaries to the Family

AN INITIATIVE TO REVITALIZE THE DOMESTIC CHURCH



Missionaries to the Family is an initiative aimed at positively impacting the Church and the world through the revitalization of the Domestic Church as called for by St. John Paul II. Missionary couples are formed and commissioned to teach and inspire families to live the Spirit of Nazareth, modeled on the Holy Family, in their homes.

Created in partnership with the McGrath Institute for Church Life at the University of Notre Dame, couples receive formation in theology and the Spirit of Nazareth. Missionary couples are then equipped to share what they have learned and experienced through spiritual friendships with other families. The formation year includes online coursework, mentorship with another missionary couple, and in-person weekend retreats. Once commissioned, missionaries work together as a couple facilitating small groups or in other forms of direct, personal accompaniment within their parish or home.

5,083 people reached through missionary activity
872 people being accompanied by missionaries for at least the past six months
1,088.5 sum total of missionary work hours per month
7.4 average hours per month worked according to survery responses
133,136 total hours of formation

Mysteries of the Rosary

CONTEMPLATING THE FACE OF CHRIST WITH MARY

We are off to the races but only just getting started!

The Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary launched for Lent 2023 and the Joyful Mysteries will be available Fall 2023. In just a few months, the series has made an instant impact for Paradisus Dei reaching over 600 groups across ten countries (not including views on WildGooseTV or FORMED). The <u>Mysteries of the</u>

Rosary series is being utilized by TMIY groups, entire parish groups, Missionaries to the Family groups, women's groups, home groups, Air Force Bases, Catholic schools, and beyond.

Most importantly, we are receiving rave reviews from the participants.

By the grace of God, this is only the tip of the iceberg. *Expanded distribution* will continue to grow and impact the spiritual lives of countless more souls. We plan for The Luminous Mysteries (2024) and The Glorious Mysteries (2025) to complete the comprehensive series over the next two years.



A CAMPAIGN FOR PARADISUS DEI

Paradisus Dei is thriving like never before in its history. Our flagship program, *That Man Is You!*, is growing at an unprecedented pace and is now in more than 860 parishes across the world. Newer programs and initiatives like *Missionaries to the Family* and *Mysteries of the Rosary* are bearing abundant fruit as well, and our newest highly promising program, *What Is Love?*, is being launched this year.

It is with tremendous enthusiasm and hopefulness that we announce that we have initiated a three-year, \$12 million funding campaign, *Lift the Spire!*, aimed at helping us reach more lives than ever with our various programs. We must seize this moment and take the next steps toward creating stronger Catholic families, a stronger Church, and a better world!

Duration: Three fiscal years (July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2026)

Campaign Type: Comprehensive (all gifts made to any Paradisus Dei

Qualified Charitable Distributions: This form of giving has become extremely popular in recent years because it is a very tax-savvy way for people who are 70½ or older to support us. If you are 70½ or older, you may contribute up to a maximum of \$100,000 (\$200,000 for a married couple) from an IRA account and forego paying taxes on the money you contribute to Paradisus Dei and your other favorite charitable organizations. If you are 73 or older, you can gift funds from your IRA that will count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD) and forego paying taxes on the funds that you gift.

Gifts of Appreciated Assets: We receive gifts of appreciated assets every year, most commonly company stock. Gifts of appreciated stock or other property that you have held for at least one year are also a tax-wise way for you to support a favorite charitable organization such as Paradisus Dei. Doing so helps you avoid costly capital gains taxes (up to 20%) and enables you to deduct the current value of the assets given (not your cost basis) up to the maximum allowable tax deduction per IRS regulations.

Matching Gifts: Many companies will match the charitable contributions of their employees, sometimes even on a 2:1 or 3:1 basis. Please inquire with your human resources department if they have a matching gift program as it can double or even triple the impact of your gift.



(JULY 1, 2022 - JUNE 30, 2023)








